



## Hello Mark,

The process requires extensive community engagement through the circulation of a petition. I've attached that below. Constituents must circulate the petition themselves and get signatures from the residents or business owners on that block for which they seek to have the signage. Once they do, they submit it to us at the Council Office; Councilwoman Park will then submit the locations via a resolution before the full City Council. The process of scheduling that may take upwards of two weeks.

Regular enforcement is another matter, contingent on resources and manpower from LADOT. We seek to make the site an enforced one but will have to work within the constraints of our City resources. At the moment, we are planning for future enforcement by getting all the hotspots in order through signage to update our profile of the areas that need the most attention.

# RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 authorizes cities to restrict the parking of vehicles, including but not limited to, vehicles that are six feet or more in height, on identified City streets during certain hours; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4 allows the Council to authorize by resolution, the streets upon which the parking of oversize vehicles shall be restricted between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, areas in Council District 11 are experiencing public safety issues associated with oversized vehicles that are often parked overnight and constrict travel lanes, thereby creating dangerous situations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council, pursuant to the Municipal Code Section 80.69.4, and the California Vehicle Code Section 22507, hereby prohibits the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over 7 feet in height, during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., along the following street segments:

- Both sides of Main Street between Rose Avenue and Sunset Avenue
- Both sides of Superior Avenue between Venice Boulevard and Victoria Avenue
- Both sides of Indiana Avenue between 5th Avenue and 4th Avenue
- Both sides of Main Street between Windward Avenue and Westminster Avenue
- Both sides of Barbara Avenue between Centinela Avenue and Frances Avenue
- Both sides of Wasatch Avenue between Matteson Avenue and Washington Place
- Both sides of Clark Avenue between Mildred Avenue and Olive Avenue
- Both sides of Victoria Avenue between Penmar Avenue and Lincoln Boulevard

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the adoption of the Resolution, the Department of Transportation be directed to post signs giving notice of a "tow away, no parking" restriction for oversized vehicles, with the specific hours detailed, at the above locations; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation be authorized to make technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Dear Council Member Park and Staff.

My husband and I are proud to be new residents of the 11th District, having just purchased our first home on Amherst Ave. on the border of Mar Vista and West LA. We have enjoyed getting to know our neighbors and mostly love our new neighborhood. Unfortunately though, since moving in only 2 weeks ago, we have learned of a few incidents of burglary and criminal activity in the neighborhood that have made us uneasy. We've also noticed that on Pearl Street, which is our nearest cross street, there have been several RV/camper vehicles parked since we arrived. These vehicles not only foster an unsafe environment and detract from the neighborhood's charm, they run gas-powered generators continuously and release toxic fumes into the air a few yards from our home. While we understand crime and homelessness are long-term, intractable issues that the City Council is working hard to address, we believe concrete action would immediately remedy the specific harms caused by the RVs.

In speaking with our neighbors, we learned that on the other side of Pearl Street, East of Bundy, signs were installed similar to the one attached. Since then, none of these vehicles are parked on that side which is great for those residents, but unfortunate for us as they have simply relocated to our side of Bundy where we do not have signs. Our neighbors reached out to LADOT about getting new signs and they indicated we will need a City Council motion to have new signage added.

We believe installing these signs will quickly and positively impact our health and safety and that of our neighbors. I would greatly appreciate your attention to this matter, and am requesting a petition to gather our neighbor's signatures in support of a motion by the City Council to install them.
